Literacy

Draw a chalk target on an outside wall, line up some snowballs and shoot to score. Award different points for hitting different areas and keep tally with a score chart making sure to count in fives.



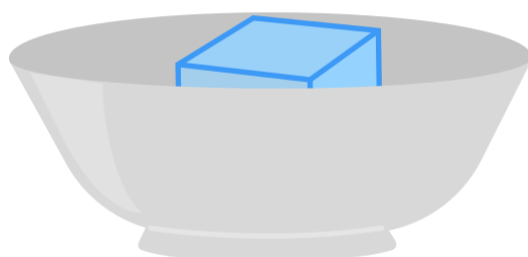
You can practise your times tables on TT Rockstars as well!
