Dear Parent/Carer

This half term, Year 6 will be studying World War II and its impact on our locality. As part of our studies, we have arranged a visit to Cannon Hall Museum on Monday 2 October 2023. The children will meet the Cook and Land Girl at Cannon Hall and become evacuees for the day in this immersive workshop. They will take part in traditional wartime activities, view real and replica objects and discover how to make tasty treats, even during rationing.

To make this experience as “realistic as possible”, Cannon Hall recommend dressing up in World War II era outfits for the day so we can all experience wartime life together! Below are suggestions from Cannon Hall on what to wear.

**What to Wear**

Skirt/blouse	Flat cap
Dress	Dark trousers/shorts
Apron	Knee length socks
Headscarf	Plain shirt
Trousers	Plain waistcoat
Woollen cardigan/Jumper	Jacket

Your child will need to arrive at school for 8.35 am as the coach will depart at 9.00 am. The coach will depart from Cannon Hall at 2.15 pm, and depending on the traffic, will return back to school at approximately 3.00 pm. **You will need to indicate on the slip below whether you will collect your child from school or allow them to walk home alone.**

Please make sure your child has an outdoor coat. Your child will also need a wartime themed packed lunch (to make the day as realistic as possible). Suggestions include: Ham, cheese or jam sandwiches, a piece of fruit, a biscuit or small chocolate bar. **Please do not bring crisps, yoghurts or other modern food items if possible. Also, no glass bottles please.** Your child **does not** need any spending money.

**We are pleased to inform you that we have been able to reduce the actual cost of this visit substantially by using funds raised from the non-uniform fundraising days last year.** The cost of this visit will be **£17.50**. Full payment is required by no later than **Monday 25 September 2023** via School Gateway. Please note, if we do not receive enough voluntary contributions to support this educational visit the school reserves the right to cancel the trip.
