Hot Chocolate Fractions

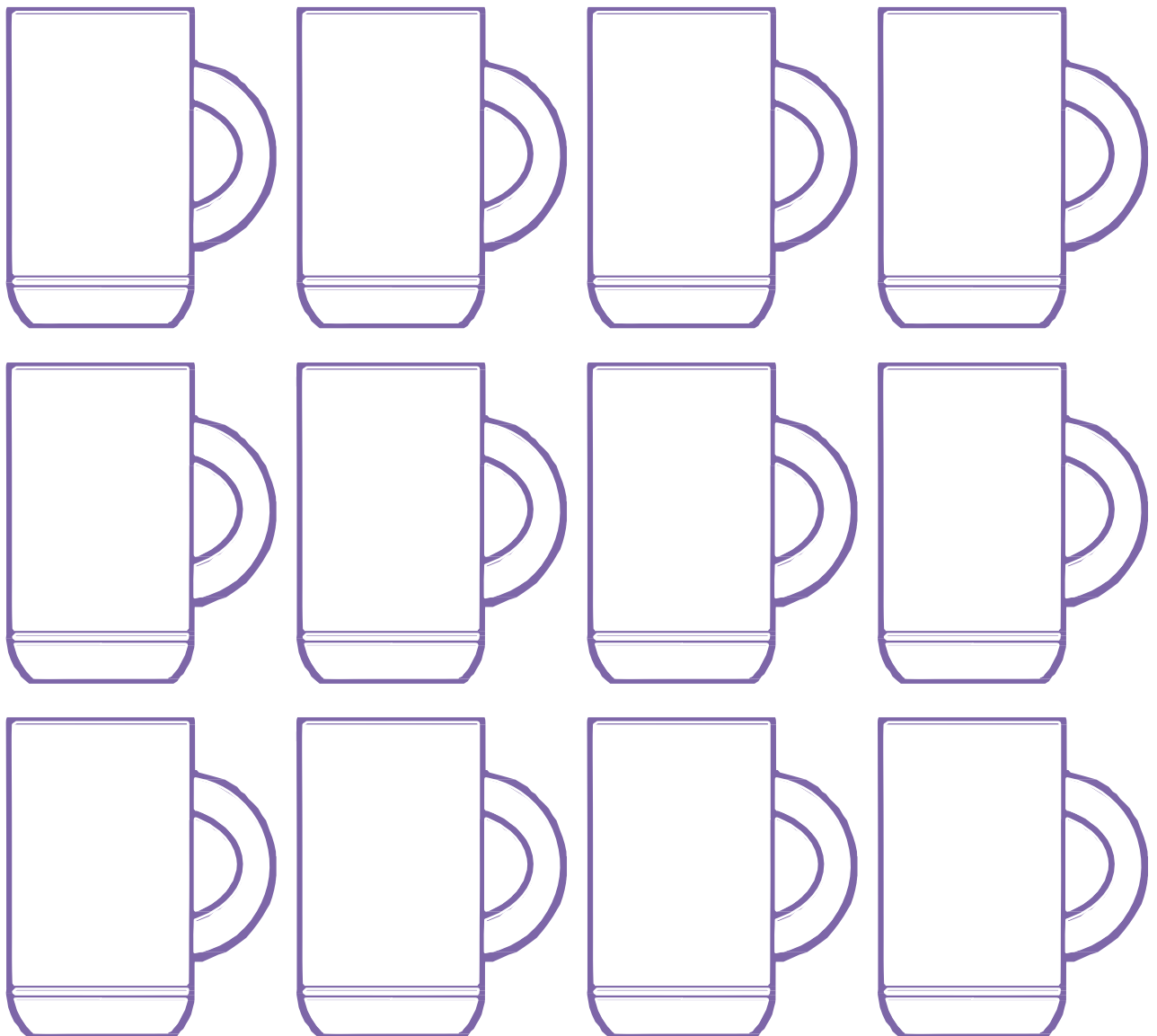


Follow the instructions to colour the hot chocolate cups.

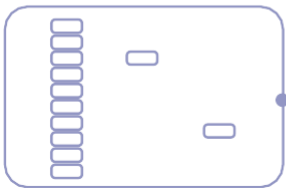
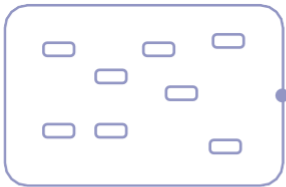
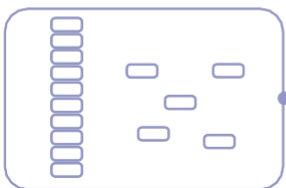


1 Write a number that has 4 tens and 3 ones.

4 Draw a line to match the snowman to the correct number representation. Can you write the numbers in words too?

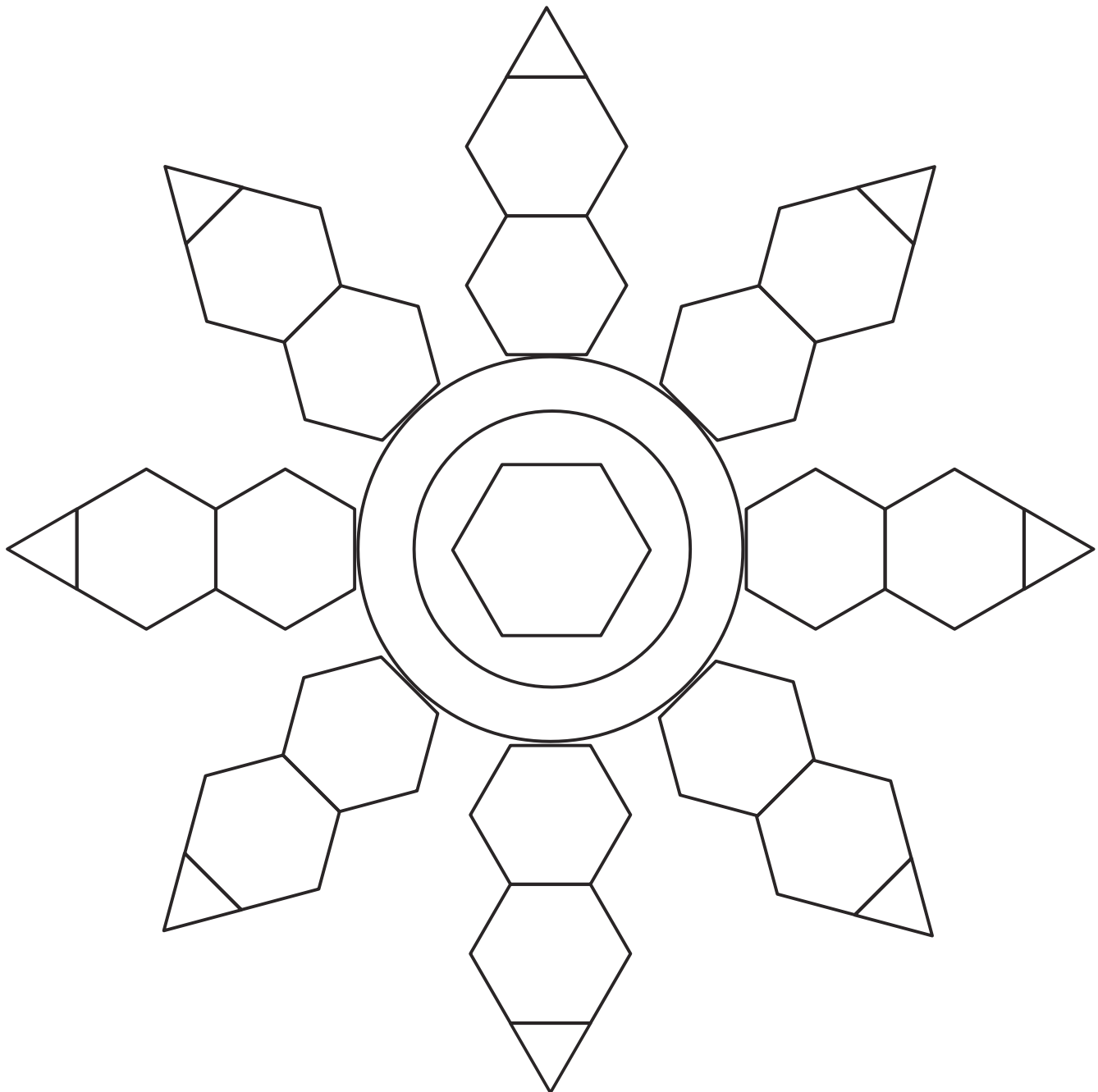


Snowflake Shape Spotter

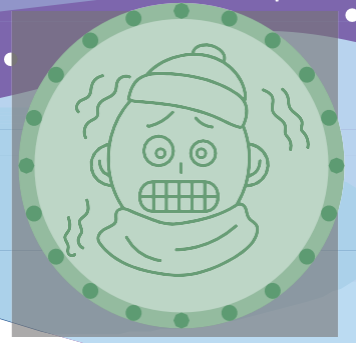


Find and colour the 2D shapes in this snowflake.
